6. Objectives of the Job (summary of the position)

The communication Officer particularly Responsible for identifying communication needs in the various segments of the project, design and implement the communication strategy with in the project. The position shall also coordinate with other activities within the project and develop appropriate communication material.

The Communications Officer is responsible for implementing communication strategy and methods in the projects, Partner NGOs and community. He/She should provide support to all the project staff, Partners and community in developing appropriate communications in preventing of STIs, HIV/AIDS, Malnutrition, Lifestyle Diseases such as Hypertension and Diabetes and Vector Borne Disease such as Dengue, Malaria and Chikungunya and foster behavior change in community. He/She shall liaise with local institutions, NGOs, and government departments in providing strategic communication support.
